INTRODUCTION:

St. Mary's Syrian College is managed by the O.S.C. (Orthodox Syrian Christian) Educational Society which has pioneered the cause of higher education in Brahmavar. The society, minority in character, has taken up the noble mission of providing university education to eligible students without distinctions of caste, creed or state.

Established in the year 1980, the college has earned pride of place for its excellent academic record, varied co-curricular activities and high standards of discipline. This has been made possible by the strenuous efforts of the staff and the co-operation of the students.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES :

The College aims at providing its students, intellectual nourishment and also inculcating such values in them as faith in God, moral uprightiness, self-confidence, sense of justice and respect for society required for a fuller life. To achieve these it proposes to:

1. Create an awareness of their duties and responsibilities, their accountability to themselves.
2. Prepare them to be conscientious in their future lives and thus pay their debt to society for the education provided.
3. Develop a broader perspective in them to become mature citizens, unaffected by parochialism of any kind.
4. Make them ambitious in life and mould them into useful citizens of the country.
5. Provide opportunities for academic excellence and encourage leadership qualities.

These are indeed lofty aims, but not unattainable. Every student has to strive in cooperation with the teachers, to achieve these ends. There is no substitute for hard work and sincerity. If only every student realises this and every parent contributes towards this goal, this college will have accomplished a great deal.

TEACHER-STUDENT RAPPORT:

The life of an individual is shaped by the people with whom one interacts constantly. At home, it may be the parents and in the college, the teachers. We have a dedicated band of teachers in our college and the students can make good use of their experience and knowledge through close personal interaction, both inside and outside the class room. Such close interaction, between the teacher and the taught has become essential today, more than ever before, to counteract the problems arising out of the impersonal atmosphere prevailing in the realm of college education. To promote rapport between the teachers and the students, we have a system of Class Advisors. Each teacher is assigned a class / a group of students and the advisor will meet the wards regularly and conduct programs to boost the self-confidence of the wards, to promote healthy interpersonal relationship and skills. The students are encouraged to meet their advisors frequently and allow themselves to be guided by the teachers.

COLLEGE ASSOCIATIONS / CLUBS:

Each student should become an active member of at least one association and must participate in as many programmes as possible. Recommendation for scholarship / freeships by the Principal will be based on the participation of students in various activities organised by the clubs and associations. The list of these associations along with the names of the advisors will be notified on the notice board.

GENERAL REGULATIONS:

1. The College Timings : Forenoon session - 9.20 a.m. to 12.25 p.m.
Afternoon session : 1.15 p.m. to 4.15 p.m. Students should be present in their respective classes by 9.20 a.m.
2. Five minutes before the classes commence both in the forenoon and the afternoon, a warning bell is given for the students to assemble in their respective classes. At 9.25 a.m., in the beginning of the first hour the lecturers enter the classes and the students rise up for the college prayer.

FOR THE ATTENTION OF ALL THE STUDENTS

1. Attendance in the Internal Assessment test is compulsory. No retest will be held for absentees.
2. As per the new University Guidelines, 75% attendance is compulsory for taking the University examinations. If it is less than 75% in any of the subjects, they cannot.
3. The Internal assessment marks will be notified on the notice board for verification by the students, as per university guidelines. Discrepancies If any, should be brought to the notice of the office and the teacher concerned. No complaints will be entertained after the submission of the marks to the University.
4. **Students' Council's office bearers will be nominated by the college on the basis of merit. There will be no elections.**
5. **Readmission to the higher class will be denied to students involved in serious acts of indiscipline, ragging and malpractices in College/ University Examinations.**

Readmission to the higher class will depend on the character, the academic performance, regularity of attendance and the behaviour of the student. Re-admission to the next higher class is not a matter of right and the college reserves the right to deny readmission to a student on valid grounds.

6. Information regarding scholarships / fee concessions etc., will be notified on Notice Board No. 2 and the students are required to apply for these as per the instructions given.

LIBRARY RULES

1. The library will be kept open from 9.00 am to 5.00 pm on all working days, including vacation and from 9.00 am to 1.30 pm on Saturdays.
2. Books will be issued only on producing the Identity card.
3. Students can borrow three books at a time. If a book borrowed is not returned on the due date, the borrower will have to pay a fine of Rs. 1/- per day for the first five days and thereafter a fine of Rs. 5/- per day will be collected.
4. Students should not write anything or make any mark in the books. A Student is expected to examine the books he/she receives and report if any damage is already there. Otherwise he / she shall be held responsible for any damage that may be detected later.
5. Students are expected to observe silence in the reading room. They should handle magazines, newspapers etc. very carefully.



FEE REGULATIONS

1. The tuition and special fees for the year are payable at the time of admission or readmission. Every student shall be liable to pay the annual fees if his/her name is on the rolls, during any part of the term.
2. If a student fails to pay his/her fee on the day fixed for payment in this calender, a fine at the rate of Rs. 5/- per day will be imposed for a month. If the fee is not paid within a month, the student's name shall be struck off the rolls. If readmitted, in addition to fine due from him/her, he/she will have to pay a readmission fee of Rs. 200/-
3. All payments to the office should be made before 1.00 pm.

CERTIFICATES:

1. All the applications for certificates must be made to the Principal in writing. Certificates must be taken from the office in person. If they have to be sent by post, a stamped self-addressed envelope must be left at the office. Certificates and marks cards will not be handed over to unauthorized persons.
2. Applications for Certificates should contain the following particulars
 - a. The student's full Name.
 - b. The date of joining the college and the class for which the student was originally enrolled.
 - c. The class in which the student was studying at the time of leaving the college and his/her register number.
 - d. The languages under Part I and the optional subjects under Part II.
 - e. The University Exams passed with Reg. No. and the year of passing.
3. The following fees are charged:
 - a. Transfer and Conduct Certificate: Rs. 250.00
 - b. Any other Certificate: Rs. 30.00
(No dues, Age, Attendance etc.)
4. Certificate will not be issued on less than 24 hours notice.
5. Those who wish to join other Universities must obtain a Migration Certificate from the Mangalore University through the college, with the prescribed fees of Rs. 1520/-.
6. Conduct Certificate is issued only when a student withdraws from the college.
7. If Transfer Certificate (T.C.) is to be sent by post the required postal charges have to be paid by the student.

SPECIAL INCENTIVES FROM THE MANAGEMENT FOR ACADEMICALLY BRILLIANT STUDENTS

The College has special schemes for academically brilliant students seeking admission to various courses of Study.

The details are given below:

1. Those students who pass the P.U.C. Examination with an aggregate of 92 percent (50% exemption) and 90% (25% exemption) and above in Science/Commerce/Arts streams from the payment of fees except those payable to the University / Government and special fees.
2. SC/ST students belonging to non-creamy layer with merit will be given exemption from the payment of all fees except those payable to the University/Government. These concessions will be withdrawn if they fail to pass the semesters with a minimum of 60 percent in the aggregate.
3. Students, who want admission in B.A. course, need not pay towards College Development Fees.
4. The students of S.M.S. Institutions who take admission in S.M.S. College will be given 10% concession in the development fees to be given at the time of admission.
5. All the above mentioned incentives will be continued during the subsequent semesters depending on the merit, behaviour and regularity of the student.
